- war in Ukraine, significant driver of security policy
- NATO/Western countries working more closely together
- governments have further increased transaction oversight to protect national security interests

Civilian aerospace

• aircraft manufacturers/airlines adapting to an increase in travel demand, as health restrictions have eased

Large scale deal activity has declined

- valuations remain high
- the number of available deals are relatively scarce
- higher interest rates

Implications for SMEs

Shorter supply chains

• Nearshoring, greater focus on tier 2 and 3 suppliers

Alternate forms of business combination/cooperation

• Outright acquisitions, smaller equity stakes, joint ventures/alliances, investment in offsets

Smaller technology-focused transactions

- · OEMs compete to fill the gaps in their strategic product and service offerings
- Focus on building technological capability to strengthen supply chains

Other

- Financial investors will also continue to play a greater role
- · Meeting environmental objectives becomes a higher priority

Lessons for the Future

- Resilience supply chain sustainability designed to adapt rapidly to geopolitical events
- Agility speed and confidence based on a strong business intelligence and superior decision-making ability
- · Flexibility consider various forms of alliances with both small and large companies
