Can Export Innovation

- Assists Canadian organizations to establish and formalize R&D partnerships with pre-identified foreign partners for the purpose of co-developing, validating or adapting a technology.
- Can Export Innovation provides funding up until the point at which partnerships are formalized.
- Supports innovators to pursue investment opportunities with foreign investors to fund R&D work.



Funding cycle: 1-year project from April 1 to March 31

Project budget: Up to \$100,000 (no set minimum)

Cost-share: 75:25, for up to \$75,000 in funding

Application process: Continuous intake. One active project at a time.

- Helps Canadian small-and-medium sized enterprises (SMEs) pursue new export opportunities for their products or services in foreign markets where they have little or no sales.
- Reduces the financial risks involved in international business development by bearing a portion of the costs that Canadian SMEs could not otherwise carry alone.
- Cooperatives in Canada are eligible for funding.



Funding cycle: Multi-year project (April 1 to March 31 fiscal year)

Project budget: \$20,000-\$100,000

Cost-share: 50:50, for up to \$50,000 in funding

Application process: Continuous intake.

Can Export SMEs is delivered in collaboration with the National Research Council Industrial Research Assistance Program (NRC-IRAP).

Eligible applicants:

For profit SMEs that:


- ✓ Are incorporated or a limited-liability partnership or a cooperative
- ✓ Have a CRA business number (unless registered on First Nations reserve lands)
- ✓ Have fewer than 500 full-time equivalent (FTE) employees
- ✓ Have \$100,000 to \$100 million in annual revenue declared in Canada during its last complete tax reporting year



What does a CanExport SMEs project look like?

Eligible markets:

Up to 5 target markets (countries or sub-national markets of Brazil, China, India and U.S.A.)



> Sales in each chosen target market must be less than \$100,000 or less than 10% of company's total sales during the company's previous tax reporting year.

Eligible activities: 7 categories (A to G)

- A. Travel to meetings/events with key contacts in target market
 - direct economy airfare for two owners or Canada-based employees
 - per diem of \$400 per person per day
 - maximum of 30 days per trip
- B. Participation in trade events to meet key contacts in target market
- C. Marketing tools creation, adaptation and translation
- D. Interpretation services
- E. IP protection, certification and adaptation of contracts
- F. Consultant Business, tax and legal advice
- G. Consultant Market research, feasibility studies, identification of key contacts and b2b facilitation


