Organizations that do not presently work with, or intend to pursue, defence related opportunities in the future, are ineligible for this program. We encourage only those businesses with a demonstrated or planned interest in defence procurement to continue with the application.

Intake will remain open until the program is fully subscribed.

This program is delivered by DAIR with support from the Government of Ontario.

Companies are not required to be members of the DAIR Innovation Network at the time of application. However, companies selected to participate will be required to join the DAIR Innovation Network upon execution of a funding agreement with DAIR. Membership is subject to the applicable annual membership fee and is renewable annually.
